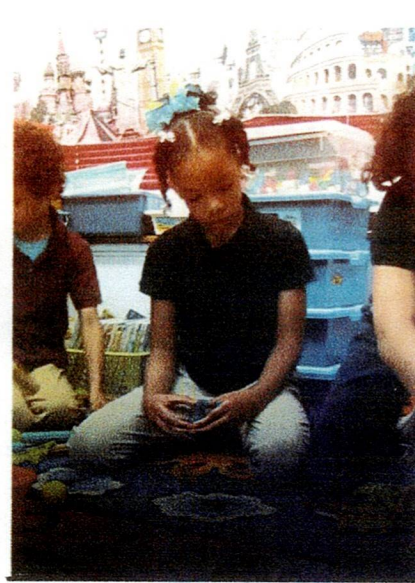


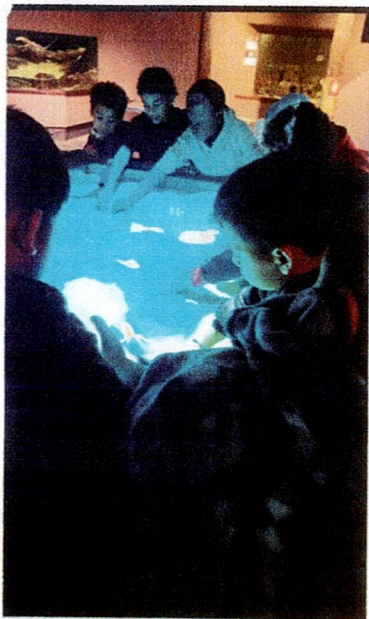

## Supporting Shanklin Elementary

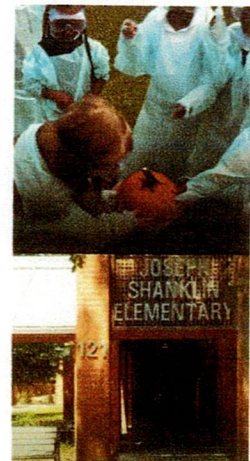
\*Every child deserves the chance to learn about the world inside and outside of the classroom. To that end the Friends of Shanklin provide:

- \*Instructional materials such as math manipulative kits, and writing notebooks, and leveled reading kits

Next year we are partnering with Shanklin to provide a 3-pronged Emergent Scholars Afterschool Program. We will utilize one-on-one volunteers to tutor struggling students, teachers will provide group instruction for students nearing proficiency, but we also will use volunteers willing to share their expertise in the arts, business, professional, or sports areas with a one time presentation for students. We will also provide bussing and snacks.

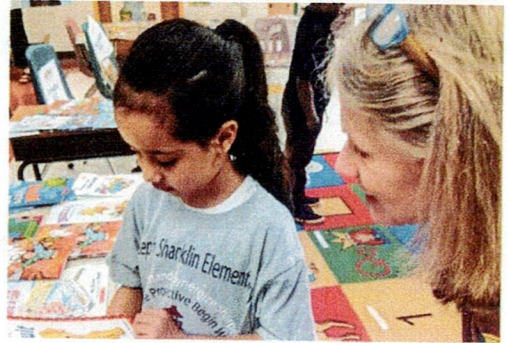
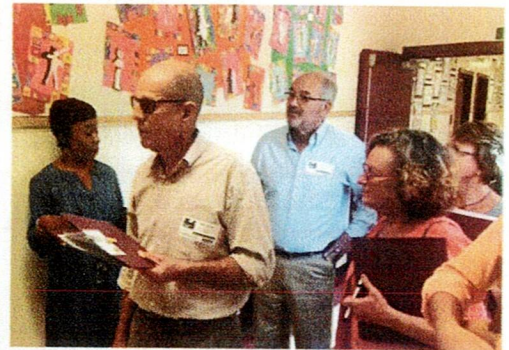
## Our FOS Mission:
